COVID-19 UPDATE

GREAT NEWS REGARDING INDOOR VISITS

The Minnesota Department of Health has released a revised visitation guidance to assisted living communities effective as early as October 17th, 2020. Pheasants Ridge is in the process of creating plans to support the safe resumption of indoor visits based on a thorough review of the new guidance along with an assessment of our current COVID-19 testing status and response plan.

We are extremely excited to share the news - we will soon be able to resume indoor visits! We will keep you informed on the timing and protocols for indoor visits by sharing weekly updates on social media and our website.

Please know the COVID-19 virus is still prevalent in our region. While we welcome the new visitation guidance from MDH, we are proceeding carefully. The ongoing pandemic may cause us to make changes to visitation if we identify a high risk to our residents and staff.

PLEASE NOTE: We will *NOT* be resuming indoor visitation at this time.

We appreciate your continued patience and understanding as we implement this next phase in our visitation policy and adapt to the changing situation that we all find ourselves in during COVID-19.
